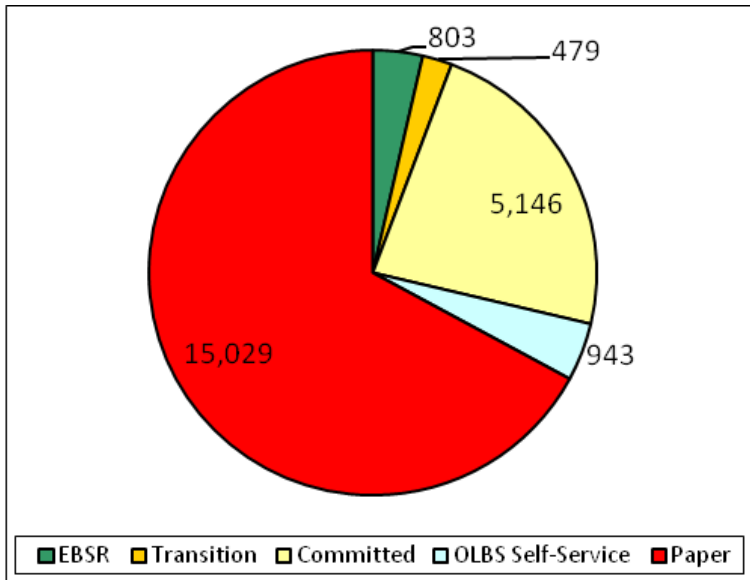


Fig 1 – Current Registrations by Type

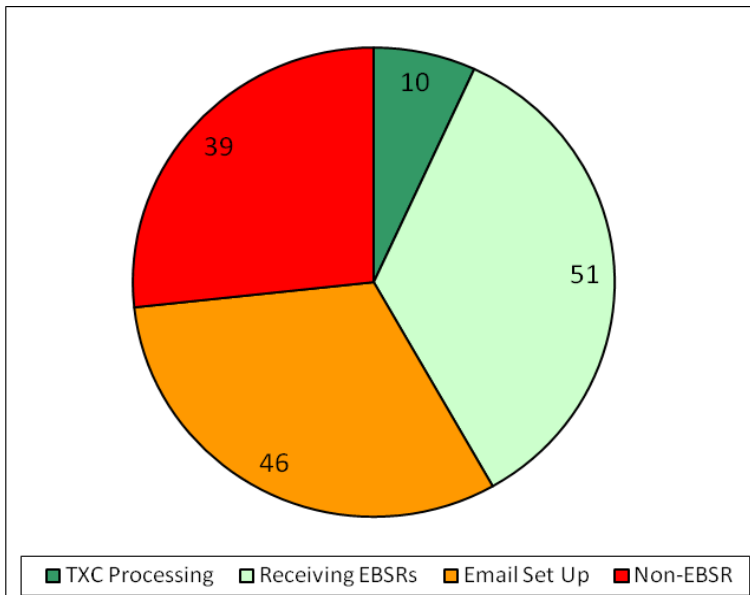


Fig 2 – Local Authorities and EBSR

Bus Service Registrations

In December 2008, some 15% of the registrations received by VOSA were in electronic format. During February 2009, VOSA received 23% of all registrations that were submitted as electronic, including more than 400 from operators in the process of conversion to EBSR. Since the launch of EBSR, VOSA have successfully handled more than 2,260 electronic registrations,

Local Authority Take-up

There are now 61 local authorities (42% of all) receiving EBSRs. 46 others have registered with VOSA in anticipation of receiving EBSRs. A growing number of authorities (10) are importing EBSR data into their local database system to take full advantage of the benefits of electronic data transfer. Others are known to be looking at doing the same.
